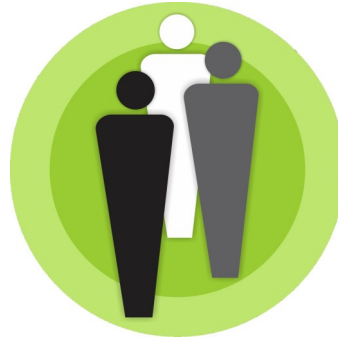

# CSE and YOUR child

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## What is CSE?

Sexuality Education has been part of the Life Orientation subject in SA schools since 2000. In 2020 the Department of Education has planned “Scripted Lesson Plans” or “SLP’s” which will introduce “comprehensive sexuality education” during LO lessons. Although CYPISA is not against teaching moral values to children, the CSE curriculum is set to enforce new knowledge.

## What are in the SLPs?

Highly explicit material that promotes promiscuity and high-risk sexual behaviors, will be presented as healthy and normal behaviour. CSE programs have an almost obsessive focus on teaching children how to obtain sexual pleasure in various ways. CSE is a “rights-based” approach to sex education and promotes sexual rights to children at the expense of their developmental health. But should the schools and class time be used for this?

## Dangers of CSE:

- ◆ Teaches children high risk sexual behaviors & promiscuity
- ◆ Normalizes anal & oral sex at age inappropriate levels
- ◆ Teaches children about masturbation
- ◆ Fails to establish abstinence as the best choice
- ◆ Teaches the killing of unborn babies
- ◆ Undermines traditional values and beliefs
- ◆ Promotes disregard for parental guidance
- ◆ Refers children to harmful resources
- ◆ Exposes children to pornographic images & sexual experimentation among peers
- ◆ Creates platforms for pedophiles & sexual offenders to exploit children
- ◆ Exposes vulnerable groups to adult material without the knowledge, presence or consent of the parents
- ◆ Encourages learners to become sex workers
- ◆ Encourages sexual experimentation
- ◆ Exposes learners to pedophile acts of teachers
- ◆ Normalizes extreme sexual choices

## How will this affect South Africa?

- ◆ There will be an increase in rape cases
- ◆ Increase in spread of HIV/AIDS
- ◆ Homosexuality will increase
- ◆ Increase in rate of killing unborn babies

## What you can do:

**Tell** your school principal or LO teachers you do not want scripted CSE taught to your child

**Support** LO teachers who do not want to teach the subject.
