Murder, gender based violence and excessive crime are part of South African life. INTERPOL has labelled South Africa the rape capital of the world. Corruption is prevalent on all levels of society. Human traffickers abduct our peers. Shopping malls and streets are no longer safe. Pornography addiction and explicit sex education in our schools trigger sexual offenses.
